Tuition Schedule:

The monthly school year tuition runs September 1st- May 31st. The days in August are not billed, as we bill for the entire month of December, even Christmas Break. Tuition is billed on the 20th of each month and payments are due by the first of each month. There are no refunds for holidays, vacation days, absent days, or snow/cold days.
