Dear Friends, The benefits of the mission school in Ak-rampa are too many to list in this letter. I could go on and on if I decided to talk about how education is changing the students. And my hope is to be able to tell you all about it in letters to come.

I believe it is in order to make mention of certain students, and how FLC and its congregation are helping the people of Akrampa. Many members of FLC have chosen to become 'sponsor parents' to students in the Akrampa school. A member and her sister sponsor two physically challenged sisters named Diana and Grace in Akrampa. This support has helped Diana and Grace to continue to attend school and further their education.

One other student, Victoria, has been greatly helped by her sponsors. Victoria's mother was killed by a tree she was felling to sell at the local market as firewood. She left 8 children behind with no one to care for them. Victoria had graduated from our Akrampa mission school and was ready to go to Senior High School to become a teacher. When her first sponsor was unable to continue the support, another FLC member stepped in, with the help of a few people from The Chapel - Sandusky.

Now Victoria is on her way to becoming a teacher. None of the success that these three students, or others, have had, would have come without the personal support of members of the congregation, like you!!! Thank you to ALL of the sponsor parents at FLC and The Chapel.
