A Day in the Life ...

Christmas in 2021

Dear Friends,

If you have been keeping up with my most recent letters, you know that I have been writing a series about the changing of the seasons and the way industries in Ghana are being forced to change and adapt. I have written three parts of that series thus far, and will finish the last part in January. However, this seemed like a good time to pause that topic and talk about Christmas.

The birth of Jesus on the day we call Christmas, and the Resurrection of Jesus on the day we call Easter, are the most celebrated days of the year in the Christian faith. Last year, in 2020, with a global pandemic sweeping the world everything about our "normal" lives had changed, including the ways in which we celebrated these special days. This year, in 2021, each of our celebrations of Christmas may still look or feel slightly different. WE may be attending our Christmas Eve church service online, instead of in person. Or if we attend church in person, we may be wearing masks and feeling uncertain if we should hug our friends. And on Christmas Day, when most of us would spend time with our entire family or all of our close friends, we may now hesitate to attend that gathering or hesitate to invite everyone to our homes.

This new world that we are living in has created such fear in many of us. We fear becoming ill with the virus, we fear our families becoming ill, we fear job loss or inability to care for our dearest loved ones in the face of illness or poverty. Sometimes, now just the small things of day-to-day life, like going to the store for food create a feeling of panic.

Everyone agrees that Covid-19 is very serious. And the entire world is mourning the loss of those precious people, valued loved ones, who we have lost since this pandemic began. It's difficult to even fathom the ongoing effects to our culture, world, and the fabric of our very lives that this pandemic may continue to bring upon us. And yet, all throughout the Bible, as each of the people therein face the most serious of challenges, even death, one message remains constant.

The Lord our God reminds us over and over: Do not be afraid.

The Bible passages most often read at Christmas are contained in the book of Luke. And while we often hear of the night that Jesus was born, we sometimes forget the verses where Mary learned that she was pregnant.

"Do not be afraid, Mary," the angel told her, "for you have found favor with God! You will conceive and give birth to a son and you will name him Jesus." Luke 1:30-31

Our hope as Christians is in Jesus. He knows every hair on our head and counts all of our tears. Jesus was sent here as a precious baby on Christmas to experience all that we do - pain, fear, joy, friendship. When you lift up your prayers to Him, he *knows* your pain. And yet, repeatedly in the Bible, God tells us not to have fear or anxiety. But to trust fully in Him at all times.

This Christmas I would like to invite you to learn more about the verses in the Bible where God is talking to His people about trusting Him and living without fear. I have **included around 100 Bible verses here**, in my letter, that are God's teachings about living without fear. I would encourage you to take a verse a week, and study the text, and the text from which it came. God wants us to take refuge in Him, and in His Word at all times, but especially when we feel afraid.

Merry Christmas to each of you, and may the New Year of 2022 bring blessings to you and your family.

<u>Isaiah 41:10</u>

Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

Deuteronomy 31:6

Be strong and courageous. Do not fear or be in dread of them, for it is the Lord your God who goes with you. He will not leave you or forsake you."

<u>Joshua 1:9</u>

Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."

<u>Psalm 27:1</u>

Of David. The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?
