This is the 50th article that I have written for you. I want to thank all of you for your interest in our shared mission in Akrampa, Ghana, and especially for your love and support of the school here. Your support is shaping the minds and hearts of generations to come, through education and the love and knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Our next group of teachers begins with Georgina Thompson. Georgina has been teaching in the Akrampa school for the past 12 years and can be considered one of our longest serving teachers. She is 37 years old and is a single parent with a daughter who is in the junior high school. Georgina has been teaching the Kindergarten class for almost all of the 12 years that she's been at the school. Georgina likes to listen to music, mainly Christian music. She is a member of the Anglican Church of Ghana.

Samuel Annan is our next teacher. Samuel has been teaching at the Akrampa school for 9 years. He is a trained agriculturist and was brought in to teach the children how to do gardening. When we established the moringa farm, he was made responsible for it, in addition to teaching the children the basics of gardening. Akrampa is not considered a specialized school, and therefore, Samuel is also required to teach all of the basic subjects. He teaches the Stage 1 Class (1st grade) along with gardening. Samuel is 50 years old. He is married with 5 children of his own. He is also a member of the Anglican Church of Ghana and assists his church in the capacity of Catechist. Samuel's main hobby is traveling.

Gloria Fiawornu is the Stage 4 (4th grade) teacher at the Akrampa School. She is the next longest serving teacher, having been with the school for the past 7 years. Gloria is 40 years old, and is married with 3 children of her own. Her specialty is mathematics, so she often assists the other teachers and classes in the instruction of mathematics along with teaching her own 4th grade class. Gloria loves to listen to Gospel music and read novels in her free time.
